Backup

- why back up?
 - in case stuff happens !!!
 - PC/drive failure
 - theft
 - flood/fire/accident
- local or on-line only?
 - local = copy on your device and copy in the cloud
 - on-line only = no copy on device, files only in cloud, need internet to view
- continuously synching
 - corruption covered as you can restore previous versions



HOW ?

- download the app from Dropbox.com
- install the app
- it makes a Dropbox folder
- move your files into Dropbox folder
- set “Settings”
