



- I'd tested with My Heritage and uploaded to Gedmatch and Family Tree DNA. I decided to test with Ancestry as well.


- Dr Gleeson spoke of "Genetic Cousins"

- The Ancestry pool was around 16,000,000





Your parents each contributed half of your DNA. Now, you can see which ethnicities you inherited from each parent—even if they haven't taken tests.






