Although masks are not yet compulsory at the Library, some of our members have personal issues which require them to take additional precautions.

#### A decision has been made to move the event outdoors, due to

- not wanting anyone to miss on our last day due to their risk concerns

- guarding against possible MBRC changes to their requirements for Library-based gatherings

- just in case we are unable to get our preferred position, I suggest
  - bringing your own chairs just in case
  - if some people could bring card tables that would be handy

- please bring a plate to share

  who are doing it tough at the moment, then please bring along something that could make their
  Christmas a little brighter (eg, non-perishable food items, toiletries, other festive items, children's
