These can include stables, garages; retaining walls, chook sheds; toilets and tennis courts.

While initially created to plan for installation of sewerage pipes across the city, the reliable maps quickly became known as the "Brisbane datum levels" and continue to define natural ground levels to determine building heights for the city.

Survey work started with the Contour Survey of Brisbane undertaken by the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Board between the 26 April 1910 and 28 March 1911 and published on 10 May 1911. (BCA0476). This Contour map is particularly useful for identifying the existence (or not) of potential pre 1911 dwellings as individual buildings in "isolated" areas are marked on the map. It also identifies areas where the majority of dwellings in this period were located.

The date for the individual detail plans range from 1911 to the 1970 depending on proximity to the inner city. These plans formed the basis of contracts for the laying of sewerage pipes across the City.

Please be aware that the amount of information on the plans reduces post 1945 as the surveying process became shorter. From the late 1960s the plans were drawn from aerial photographs.
